THINGS TO KNOW & FOLLOW:

- **Backpacks** clearly under a table; classes are full and for safety reasons we need the space to move.
- **Phones** are turned in at the beginning of class and put into a table lock box.
- **Lectures** when I teach please be respectful of peers and teacher, this is primarily a studio/ lab course so the time you need to listen is when you are learning what & how to do.
- **Clean UP** each Unit requires different jobs at clean up- there is a posted class **Studio Practice** sheet we will rotate but at end of period the table caddies must be cleaned out and reorganized (like sharpener containers emptied). NO table is released until their table is set-up for the next class.

- **Folders** because of volume of class must be put away in the proper fashion to protect your work and the work of others.
- **Supplies** are kept and then put back into your **PERIOD BOX**
- Part of your own education is taking responsibility for your materials- keep your studio/space clean.
- **Food- not allowed- chemical and arts supplies can be dangerous- no eating!**
- **Water-** OK have bottle filled or use room sink- no leaving to fill up water
